Access AdStor

To access the AdStor user interface, log into https://www.adstor.tv with your designated username and password. After your initial login, you can change your password by clicking on your name at the top right of the screen.






User Access to Information and Features

AdStor includes rights management to ensure that access to your information and Ad assets is available to only authorized user accounts. In addition, User Roles have been established to grant access to a set of features and actions. Interface Layout

After logging in, the default view will look similar to the screenshot below:

In the left navigation panel, the "Asset View" section contains the main views for completing most operational functions, including the following:

- The "Make List" view is the default view and allows you to enter Ad-ID/ISCI codes/Asset ID and view information on the Ad content in AdStor as well as distribute the selected Ad content. This view also provides status on any processing or order involved the Ad content entered.
- The "Catalog" view provides a list of all the Ad Content you currently can access in AdStor. This is also the view that will assist you in finding status on any Ad Content.
- The "Distributed Ad Assets" view not only provides the list of Ad Content that have been distributed to
 assigned destinations but also provides the MAID (Movie Asset ID) and other important information for
 each distributed Ad Content.
- The "Order" view provides a list of all orders, order status and information for each Delivery of Ad Content within an order.

Returning to the default view is available by clicking on the Comcast Technology Solutions logo at top left corner of the screen.



Hiding and exposing the left navigation panel is available by clicking on the arrow next to the Asset View.
